MOVE-UP REGULATIONS: Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made in writing to the trial secretary only. Move-ups for Saturday, April 24th must be received not later than 6:00 p.m. on Monday, April 19th. Move-ups for Sunday, April 25th will be accepted on Saturday, April 24th until the last ribbon has been awarded. Dogs so moved up will be entered at the end of the running order, and every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs in the same class. Move-ups are not allowed from Novice A to Novice B after the closing date of this trial.

**MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARDS:** Exhibitors are no longer required to submit a copy of their dog's jump height card with their entry or show it the day of the show at check in. Instead, please fill out the section at the top of the entry form. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

**HEIGHT DIVISIONS:** Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Judges reserve the right to measure all dogs without a valid height card. Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division in the Regular program, but not in a lower division than their proper height division. Handlers must run in their proper height division in the Preferred program.

**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:** Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, excused, disqualified, or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Bitches that come into season after the closing date and injured dogs may have their entry fee returned, less an administrative fee, by providing the trial secretary with a signed statement from a veterinarian at least ½ hour before judging begins.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner/handler is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Conflicts between rings should be discussed with the judge prior to the start of the class and the gate steward notified.

Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the show grounds clean. Please pick up after your dogs. Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dog will be excused from the trial weekend with no monies refunded.

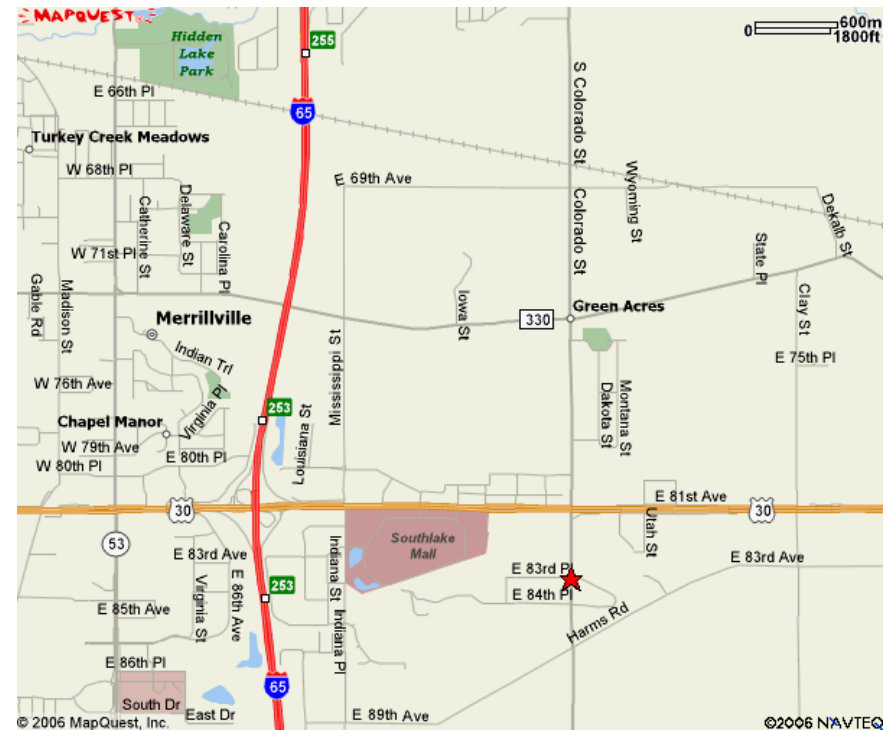
Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

**SITE INFORMATION:** The agility trial will be held at the Soccerville Vetta Sportsclub, 8328 Colorado Street, Merrillville, IN. This trial will be held indoors on soccer turf. Indoor crating is allowed, crate mats or other ground cover must be used underneath all crates. Food is available on site, and there are fast food restaurants nearby. Dogs must be walked in the designated exercise areas. Anyone found exercising their dogs across the street from the complex will be asked to leave with no monies refunded!

The complex is approximately 1.8 miles east of I-65 and just off US 30. From I-65, exit at US 30 and go east. Go past Southlake Mall to Colorado and turn right. Colorado is not marked, so look for the Sportmart sign on the southeast corner of US 30 and Colorado. The complex will be less than ½ mile down Colorado, on the right side of the street.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all **Regular** tiling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative or a Volunteer Measuring Official prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

**Mixed breed classes** may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC all-breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation.

**Junior Handlers** should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
